The Mission House is a large single family home (2,500 square feet) with eight rooms.

Common areas: The combined living room/dining room area provides ample space for meals and group gatherings. The large recreation room contains a ping pong table, bumper pool, games, a TV, VCR/DVD player, and stereo. Two sitting rooms offer a piano and comfortable places to relax.

**Sleeping quarters:** A maximum of 25 people can be housed in the Mission House on cots, mats and beds (one king, one double, two twin beds and a double pull out couch). Guest provide their own bedding (sleeping bags, sheets, pillows and blankets).

**Bathrooms:** There is a half bath on the first floor and full bath on the second floor. Additional restrooms and shower facilities are available in the church fellowship hall located approximately 200 feet from the Mission House on the James Island Presbyterian Church campus. Use of showers and restrooms in the fellowship hall are limited to specific times due to use of the building by other groups.

The Mission House has a fully furnished kitchen including fridge, stove, microwave, dishwasher and coffee makers. There is also a washer/dryer and gas grill available.

#### We provide:

### Guests provide:

- bedding
- towels
- food for meals (grocery stores near by)
- paper products

**Supervision:** Youth Groups are required to have one adult supervisor for 6 volunteers.

Security: the work group leader will be responsible for locking the Mission House and adjacent fellowship hall/gymnasium.

**Cleanliness:** Work groups are expected to leave the Mission House clean when they finish their stay. A check list of cleaning tasks is available on our website. Please leave the mission house better than you found it!

Health and Safety: no alcohol, drugs, tobacco, weapons, or pets are permitted.
